CONFERENCE FEE

If paid before May 31, 2011:

Normal: 300 Euros
Reduced: 150 Euros (for students)

If paid after May 31, 2011:

Normal: 400 Euros
Reduced: 200 Euros (for students)

The conference fee includes conference dinner and excursion. The conference fee can only be paid with a credit card and is carried out on-line at the conference web page. A confirmation email will be received after the payment. The receipt in printed form will be available upon request at the registration desk during the conference.

ACCOMMODATION

The accommodation for the participant and his/her possible accompanying persons needs to be taken care of by the participant himself/herself. Special rates for the participants of the conference have been negotiated for the Hotel Kompas and Hotel Lovec. The Hotel Kompas is the Conference venue, whereas the Hotel Lovec is situated in its near vicinity (100m). The rates per night are 91 EUR for a single room and 104 EUR for a double room. For students who are willing to share a double room with another student the rate is 78 EUR for a room.
